



Vietnam Classic Tour (06 Nights/07 Days)

03 Nights Hanoi/02 Nights Danang/01 Night Ho Chi Minh

DETAILED ITINERARY:

DAY1: ARRIVAL HANOI AIRPORT – CHECK IN HOTEL (--)

Welcome to Hanoi, the capital city of Vietnam. Upon arrival, greeted by the local tour guide and transfer to downtown. Check in your hotel.

Afternoon, visit **Ba Dinh Square** – the biggest square in Hanoi where all the biggest cultural, political events of the cities, especially demonstrations, take place. Start our visit at the **Complex of Ho Chi Minh** including Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (from outside only as it closes in the afternoon), **Ho Chi Minh's house-on-stilts**, his fish pond and the **One-Pillar Pagoda**. Then, the **Temple of Literature** which is considered as the first university of Vietnam. Later, we have an overall view of the capital by **cyclo in 1 hour**, which wanders around the Old Quarter of Hanoi and the Hoan Kiem Lake (the "Sword" Lake). From here wandering on the narrow streets of the Old Quarter to experience the daily life of the local people. Transfer back to your hotel.

Overnight in Hanoi.

Please note: the standard check in time is 14:00 – 15:00pm. Early check in is not included and subject to hotel availability.

Night activities suggestion: enjoy local beer at Ta Hien Streets, experience the ambience of sleepless street with life music, the young people of Hanoi and also foreign tourists. Hundreds of bars and pubs in the Old Quarter are also at your disposal or just simple spend your time at shopping malls or various boutique Shops

DAY2: HANOI – HALONG BAY – HANOI (B)

07h30-08h00: Picking up from the hotel (in Hanoi Old Quarter area) and departing for Ha Long, stop over for a rest on the way.

10:00: Upon arrival at Tuan Chau harbour, you will check-in and get on board the cruise then starts a trip to discover the World Heritage.

10:30: Enjoy welcome drink. The cruise departs from Tuan Chau harbor for a joyful journey to discover the beauty of the world heritage Ha Long Bay. Along the way, you will have chance to pass through the grandeur of the legendary bay with thousands of limestone islands such as: Dog Rock, Duck Rock and especially Thumb Rock - a beautiful limestone islet rising from sea water in the shape of a giant thumb. Mother Nature has put Thumb Rock here to send a message of goodness to every passenger cruising in the ancient bay.

12:00: Have a huge buffet lunch with variety of dishes including seafood and Vietnamese traditional food.

13:00: Stop at Bo Hon Island. Our tour guide will take you to Sung Sot Cave/Surprising Cave, the largest and the most beautiful cave in Halong Bay. After about 200 steps under forest canopy, the entrance of the cave shows up. A paradise of appear in front of you. You will discover the cave in about 45 minutes before getting back to the cruise (For other tourists whom can't walk much, you can stay on cruise, chilling out on the sundeck).

14:00: Say goodbye to Sung Sot Cave, cruise heads to Luon Cave. In this area, it's time for you to heat up with kayaking (about 30 minutes kayaking)

15:00: Stop at Titov Island. On this small island, you can climb halfway up the mountain to enjoy a panoramic view of Ha Long Bay. Looking down from high above gives you a wonderful sensation; at the same time offers you a spectacular view of every corner of the bay.

16:00: After that, you will get back to cruise and ready for our Sunset Party. Vietnamese tea, fresh fruits and snacks will be served when you're relaxing on the sundeck or in the Jacuzzi.

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On the way back, cruise will pass by Hoa Cuong area, one of the most beautiful spots in the bay.

17:30-18:00: Arrive in Tuan Chau port. End of the trip.

Lunch with Local Food.

Overnight in Hanoi.

***Note:** Cruise itinerary and schedule are subject to change due to weather, tide levels and operating conditions. Swimming or kayaking excursions may be cancelled due to poor weather.*

DAY3: HANOI – NINH BINH – HANOI (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Located in Ninh Binh province 100 km southeast of Hanoi, Hoa Lu and Tam Coc are two of the most picturesque spots in all the north. For 41 years, from 968 to 1009 CE, Hoa Lu was the ancient capital of Vietnam. Nearby Tam Coc is often referred to as “Ha Long among the rice paddies.” Visitors are conveyed by rowboat along the peaceful Tam Coc stream past green fields and the feet of mountains into the mouths of caves, where they encounter new surprises, like stalactites and stalagmites that shimmer like gemstones just inches from the water. Itinerary Hoa Lu - Tam Coc Tour: 07h45-08h30: We pick you up at your hotel in Old Quarter, departure for Hoa Lu - Tam Coc, enjoying the beautiful sceneries of the rural areas on the way. 10h30: After arriving in Ninh Binh province, the guide takes you to visit Hoa Lu - the Ancient Royal capital of Viet Nam.

We will visit Dinh king temple and Le king temple, in the 10th century, finding out the heroic histories of this two Kings in Chinese Wars. After that, we go to Tam Coc (10 km far from Hoa Lu). 12h00: Have lunch at local restaurant. After lunch you will get on bamboo boat - rowed by the local people - in Hoang Long River to visit Tam Coc (three caves) on the way. You pass through three enormous caves that provide a brief respite from the intense summer sun. It takes approximately two hours to go up and down the river and along the way, you witness local fisherfolk, village life along the river and, of course, the striking limestone karst formations that Tam Coc is famous for. 16h30: We take the car come back Ha Noi. 19h30: We arrive Ha Noi and finish the tour. Overnight at hotel in Ha Noi.

DAY4: HANOI – DANANG BY FLIGHT (B)

Breakfast at hotel. We disembark and transfer to Hanoi airport for your trip to Da Nang. Upon arrival in Danang check-in at hotel.

Afternoon will transfer to go to Hoi An Old Town. You will visit Hoi An Old Town by foot. You will have an opportunity to visit Hoi An Market, Historical House, Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall, Japanese covered bridge and Art Craft Manufacturing, artwork galleries in the old town.

Overnight in Da Nang

DAY5: DANANG – DAY TRIP BA NA HILLS - DANANG (B)

After breakfast morning, transfer to Ba Na hills area where your cable car transfer will be waiting to take you up to an altitude of 1487m above sea level. This is the second longest cable car in the world, with a difference of 1292m between the 2 stations. On a visit to Ba Na hills, you will be able to enjoy visits to an ecological park, a theme park, a pagoda, and a mock French village (not including Wax Museum). Accompanied by a tour guide, you can walk the “Golden Bridge” – the pedestrian walkway offering tourist’s uninterrupted views of the majestic landscape beneath. Next you will have some free time to explore the park some more, discover the games and other entertainment areas. Spend more time to relax at your preference then make your way back to the cable car to venture back down the mountain to meet up with your guide again and transfer back to your hotel in Danang.



Overnight in Da Nang

DAY6: DANANG – HO CHI MINH CITY BY FLIGHT (B)

Breakfast at hotel and for a short transfer without guide to Danang airport. Embark on your flight to Ho Chi Minh city, the big metropolis of the South. You are greeted upon arrival and driven to your hotel in the city centre, historically called Saigon.

Transfer to visit the **Independence Palace**, the former residence of the President of South Vietnam with the “War Room”, where the South Vietnamese forces were controlled, and the room where the North Vietnamese army finally took control in the Fall of Saigon on in 1975. Next visit is the **War Remnants Museum**, which was previously known as the “Museum of American War Crimes” and contains countless artifacts and photographs documenting said crimes - the killing of civilians, spreading of chemicals, torturing of prisoners, and the effects of the war on the north. Planes, tanks, bombs, and helicopters displayed, and outside the museum are some rooms displaying cultural products of Vietnam.

Then head to **Notre Dame Cathedral**, which was built between 1877 and 1883 with materials mostly imported from France. Neo-Romanesque in form, it is a major center of Catholicism in modern Vietnam, and one of the city’s major landmarks.

Overnight in Saigon/Ho Chi Minh.

DAY7: MEKONG DELTA FULL DAY TOUR - DEPARTURE FLIGHT (B)

After breakfast takes you to My Tho, the capital of Tien Giang Province. Situated on the Mekong River, 75 kilometers southeast of Ho Chi Minh City, the city is surrounded by orchards and rice fields, which produce grain for the entire country. Visit one or two of the islands that produce traditional handcrafts, coconut candy and bee farms. Visit the Vinh Trang Pagoda, the oldest one in the delta on your boat trip on the Mekong River. Return to Ho Chi Minh City. Later, move to the airport for your departure flight
