DAY 01: ARRIVAL MUMBAI

You will arrive at Mumbai International Airport. Following customs, immigration formalities and baggage collection, our representative will meet you as you Exit the Arrivals Terminal building after which you would be transferred to Hotel.

Mumbai: formerly Bombay is the capital of the Indian state of Maharashtra. The city proper has approximately 14 million people and, along with the neighboring suburbs of Navi Mumbai and Thane, Mumbai forms the world's 4th largest urban agglomeration with around 19 million people. Mumbai lies on the west coast of India and has a deep natural harbor. Mumbai's port handles over half of India's maritime cargo

DAY 02: MUMBAI

Breakfast at hotel. Later drive to visit **The Gateway of India** was built to commemorate the visit of King George V and Queen Mary for the Delhi Durbar in 1911. Situated at the Apollo Bunder, the gateway holds greater historical significance as the last of the British troops that left India by sea, marched through its portals. The monument is complete with four turrets and intricate latticework carved into the yellow basalt stone.



The **Elephanta Caves** are located on island hills approximately covering an area of 7 km in circumference. The island is named after a colossal elephant found in the island, which is popularly known as 'Gharapuri'. In ancient period, the place is variously identified as Puri which is mentioned in the Aihole inscription of Pulakesin II. It seems, different dynasties held their sway over this island, namely, the Konkan-Mauryas, Trikutakas, Chalukyas of Badami, Silaharas, Rashtrakutas, Kalyani Chalukyas, Yadavas of Deogiri, Muslim rulers of Ahmedabad and then by the Portuguese. The Marathas also had this island under their control and from them it passed into the control of the British.



Lunch at Local City Restaurant/Hotel

After lunch proceed to visit **The Prince of Wales Museum** is one of the major attractions of Mumbai. Built in the year 1914, it is surrounded by a beautiful landscape

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forming an ideal getaway for the people of Mumbai. The museum houses art, sculpture, rare coins, and old firearms and a priceless collection of miniature paintings. The Prince of Wales museum is regarded as one of the best museums in the country. Drive past **Marine Drive**.

DAY 03: MUMBAI-NAGPUR-PENCH

Breakfast at Hotel. After breakfast transfer to Mumbai airport to connect flight for Nagpur. On arrival Nagpur you will meet and assist our representative and drive to Pench (85 KM/2 Hrs). When you will reach at Pench directly transfer to hotel for check inn.

Pench National Park is a national park in India's Madhya Pradesh state, established in 1975 with an area of 257.26 km² (99.33 sq mi). It includes Pench Tiger Reserve and derives its name from the Pench River that flows through the park from north to south dividing the park into almost equal western and eastern halves, the well-forested areas of Seoni and Chhindwara districts respectively. It was declared a sanctuary in 1965, raised to the status of national park in 1975 and enlisted as a tiger reserve in 1992. In 1983 it was declared as National Park.

DAY 04: PENCH

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast proceed to visit **Pench National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Morning Jeep safari entry time is 06:00 hrs & Exit time is 11:00 hrs from October to June.

Pench National Park, The major Carnivores are Tiger, leopard, wild cat, wild dog, hyena, jackal, fox, wolf, weasel among the vegetarian species, Gaur, Nilgai, Sambar, Chital, Chasinga, Chinkara, Wild Pig etc. are prominent. In this Tiger Reserve, birds of about 325 species can also be seen in various seasons of the year. In the sunny areas of the Totladoh reservoir situated inside the park limits, there is a lot of migratory birds seen in the cold season. Among the migratory birds, Ruddy shelduck, Pintail, Whistling Teal and Vegtel etc are prominent

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast proceed to visit **Pench National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Morning Jeep safari entry time is 06:00 hrs & Exit time is 11:00 hrs from Oct. to June.

Back to hotel & take rest.

After Lunch proceed to visit **Pench National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Evening Jeep safari entry time is 15:00 hrs & exit time is 18:00 hrs from Oct. to June.

DAY 06: PENCH-KANHA

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast drive to Kanha (aprox 200 KM / 5 Hrs).

Kanha National Park is nestled in the Maikal range of Satpuras in Madhya Pradesh, the heart of India that forms the central Indian highlands. The national park is being popularized as the Tiger reserve and interestingly is being declared as one of the finest wildlife areas in the world. Spreading across two revenue districts the Mandala and the Kalaghat, Kanha National Park was declared a reserve forest in 1879 and revalued as a wildlife sanctuary in 1933. Its position was further upgraded to a national park in 1955.

The Kanha National Park is spread across the area of 940 sq km in the Maikal chain of hills. By bringing up the buffer and core zone all together, the Kanha Tiger Reserve has the total area of 1945 sq km.



On arrival Kanha transfer to hotel for check inn. Take rest.

Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 07: KANHA

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast proceed to visit **Kanha National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Morning Jeep safari entry time is from sunrise & Exit time is 11:00 hrs from Oct. to Apr. And in May – Jun time is from sunrise & Exit time is 10:00 hrs

Kanha National Park is the host of the major animals (mammals) including the Barasingha or swamp deer (*Rucervus duvaucelii*), Indian wild dog and the most famed the India Tiger. This park is mostly renowned as the “Tiger Reserve” due to the significant amount of population of tigers in the Kanha land. Apart from that the most famed Barasingha can be found in abundance in this reserve and thus this species can be suitable called as the “jewel of Kanha National Park”.

Back to hotel & take rest.



After Lunch proceed to visit **Kanha National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Evening Jeep safari entry time is 14:00 hrs & exit time is on sunset from Oct. to Feb. From Feb to Apr. entry time is 15:00 hrs & exit time is on sunset. From Apr. to Jun entry time is 15:30 hrs & exit time is on sunset.

Back to Hotel & take rest.

DAY 08: KANHA

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast proceed to visit **Kanha National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Morning Jeep safari entry time is from sunrise & Exit time is 11:00 hrs from Oct. to Apr. And in May – Jun time is from sunrise & Exit time is 10:00 hrs

Back to hotel & take rest.

After Lunch proceed to visit **Kanha National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Evening Jeep safari entry time is 14:00 hrs & exit time is on sunset from October to February. From Feb to April entry time is 15:00 hrs & exit time is on sunset. From May to Jun entry time is 15:30 hrs & exit time is on sunset.

Back to Hotel & take rest.

DAY 09: KANHA-BANDHAVGARH

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast drive to Bandhavgarh (aprox 250 KM / 6 Hrs).

Bandhavgarh National Park is spread over the Vindhya hills in Madhya Pradesh. The national park consists of a core area of 105 sq km and a buffer area of approximately 400 sq km. The topography of the whole area varies between steep ridges, undulating forest and open meadows. Bandhavgarh National Park is known for the Royal Bengal Tigers. The density of the tiger population at Bandhavgarh is the highest known in India as well as in the world. The national park was the former hunting preserve of the Maharaja of Rewa and at present is a famous natural hub for White Tigers. White Tigers, now a major attraction around the world's zoos, were first discovered in Rewa, not far from here. It is also believed that all the white tigers across the globe trace their roots to Bandhavgarh.



On arrival Bandhavgarh transfer to hotel for check inn. Take rest.

Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 10: BANDHAVGARH

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast proceed to visit **Bandhavgarh National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Morning Jeep safari entry time is from 06:30 Hrs & Exit time is 11:00 hrs from Oct. to March. And in April to Jun time is from 05:30 Hrs & Exit time is 10:00 hrs

The Faunas Available At Bandhavgarh National Park is White Tigers, Bengal Tigers, Leopards, Sambar, Barking Deer, Nilgai, Wild Boar, Gaur, Chausingha and Chinkara, the Asiatic jackal, Bengal fox, sloth bear, ratel, grey mongoose, striped hyena, jungle cat, leopard and tiger.

Back to hotel & take rest.



After Lunch proceed to visit **Bandhavgarh National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Evening Jeep safari entry time is 14:30 hrs & exit time 17:30 Hrs from Oct. to March. From April to Jun entry time is 16:00 hrs & exit time is 19:00 Hrs.

Back to Hotel & take rest.

DAY 11: BANDHAVGARH

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast proceed to **visit Bandhavgarh National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Morning Jeep safari entry time is from 06:30 Hrs & Exit time is 11:00 hrs from Oct. to March. And in April to Jun time is from 05:30 Hrs & Exit time is 10:00 hrs

Back to hotel & take rest.

After Lunch proceed to visit **Bandhavgarh National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Evening Jeep safari entry time is 14:30 hrs & exit time 17:30 Hrs from Oct. to March. From April to Jun entry time is 16:00 hrs & exit time is 19:00 Hrs.

Back to Hotel & take rest.

DAY 12: BANDHAVGARH-KHAJURAHO

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast drive to Khajuraho (approx 265 KM / 6 Hrs). On arrival Khajuraho transfer to hotel for check inn.

Take lunch at city restaurant/hotel.

After lunch visit **Khajuraho temples**, were built between 885 CE and 1000 CE by the Chandela dynasty. Historical records note that the Khajuraho temple site had 85 temples by the 12th century, spread over 20 square kilometres (7.7 sq mi). Of these, only about 25 temples have survived, spread over six square kilometres (2.3 sq mi). Of the surviving temples, the Kandariya Mahadeva Temple is decorated with a profusion of sculptures with intricate details, symbolism, and expressiveness of ancient Indian art. The temple complex was forgotten and overgrown by the jungle until 1838 when Captain T.S. Burt, a British engineer, visited the complex and reported his findings in the Journal of the Asiatic Society of Bengal.

Overnight stay at the hotel.



**DAY 13: KHAJURAHO-JHANSI-AGRA****BY SURFACE/TRAIN****(B/L/D)**

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast drive to Jhansi (175 KM/ 3 Hrs). On arrival Jhansi take lunch at city restaurant/hotel.

After lunch transfer to Jhansi railway station to connect train for Agra.

On arrival at Agra railway station our representative will meet you and transferred to Hotel. Check Inn & dinner at hotel.

Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 14: AGRA**BY SURFACE****(B/L/D)**

After breakfast at hotel proceed to visit **Taj Mahal by sunrise (closed on Fridays)**. The Taj Mahal is everything that has been said about it and more. Taking 22 years and 20,000 men to build, the white marble was quarried 200 miles away and was transported to the site by a fleet of 1000 elephants. Built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan as an expression of his love for his wife Mumtaz Mahal, in mid 17th century, the Taj Mahal is truly one of the wonders of the world. Though the Taj appears to be amazingly perfect from almost any angle, it is the close-up marble inlay work, which is really astounding. You will have ample time to view and be mesmerized by this outstanding piece of architecture.



Also visit the **Agra Fort**, an outstanding example of Mughal architecture. Agra Fort - the seat and the strong hold of the Mughal Empire under successive generations. This was the seat of Mughal rule and administration and the present structure owes its origins to Akbar who erected the walls and gates and the first buildings on the eastern banks of Yamuna River. Shah Jehan added the impressive quarters and the mosque while Aurangzeb added the outer ramparts. Visit its Hall of Public Audience and its Royal Pavilions.

DAY 15: AGRA-RANTHAMBORE**BY SURFACE****(B/L/D)**

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast drive to Ranthambore (approx 310 KM / 6 Hrs).



Ranthambore National Park was established as the Sawai Madhopur Game Sanctuary in 1955, initially covering an area of 282 km² (109 sq mi). It was declared one of the Project Tiger reserves in 1973. Ranthambore is known for its Bengal tiger population. During the past few years, there has been a decline in numbers due to poaching and other reasons. The number of tigers was 25 in 2005 and 48 in 2013. As of 2022, there were 80 tigers in the park

On arrival Ranthambore transfer to hotel for check inn. Take rest.

Overnight stay at the hotel.



DAY 16: RANTHAMBORE

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast proceed to visit **Ranthambore National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Morning Jeep safari entry time is from 06:30 Hrs & Exit time is 10:00 hrs from Oct. to March. And from April to Jun time is from 06:00 Hrs & Exit time is 09:30 hrs

Back to hotel & take rest.

After Lunch proceed to visit **Ranthambore National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Evening Jeep safari entry time is 14:00 hrs & exit time 17:30 Hrs from Oct. to March. From April to Jun entry time is 15:00 hrs & exit time is 18:30 Hrs.

Back to Hotel & take rest.

DAY 17: RANTHAMBORE

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast proceed to visit **Ranthambore National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Morning Jeep safari entry time is from 06:30 Hrs & Exit time is 10:00 hrs from Oct. to March. And from April to Jun time is from 06:00 Hrs & Exit time is 09:30 hrs

Back to hotel & take rest.

After Lunch proceed to visit **Ranthambore National Park by Jeep Safari** (duration approx 3 Hrs). Evening





Jeep safari entry time is 14:00 hrs & exit time 17:30 Hrs from Oct. to March. From April to Jun entry time is 15:00 hrs & exit time is 18:30 Hrs.

Back to Hotel & take rest.

Overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 18: RANTHAMBORE-DELHI DEPARTURE BY SURFACE

Breakfast at hotel. After breakfast drive to Delhi (380 KM/ 6 Hrs). On Arrival Delhi lunch at city local restaurant.

After lunch visit in Delhi **Qutab Minar** is the tallest brick minaret in the world and an important example of Indo-Islamic Architecture. The Qutub Minar and its monuments are listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



Visit India Gate, Parliament House & President House (by Car view).

After dinner timely transfer to Delhi airport to connect flight for your own destination.
